Dear Educators and Parents,

As a way to promote reading, The Mount Laurel Fire Department and the Mount Laurel Library are excited to announce the ninth year of the Get Fired Up for Literacy program. This is a reading contest for all Mount Laurel public school students in grades 1-4. The contest will begin Friday, December 22, 2017 and will end Friday, January 5, 2018.

One student from each grade who reads the most minutes during this time period will be deemed a winner. There will be four prize winners per school.

One grand prize winner will be randomly selected at each school from the pool of winners mentioned above. Each grand prize winner will receive a ride to school in a fire truck.

Finally, each student who participates and reads a minimum of 60 minutes will receive a certificate.

Note: Previous grand prize winners are not eligible for fire truck rides.

The grand prize winners will receive a telephone call from the Mount Laurel Fire Department prior to the results being posted on the Mount Laurel Fire Department's website. The winners will be posted Friday, January 12, 2018 and the fire truck rides will be arranged shortly thereafter.
